- 3) Ranked in the top 10% of his graduating class.
- 4) An essay submitted by the candidate that does NOT exceed 225 words.
- 5) Listing all swimming and academic accomplishments on the local, state and national level.
- 6) Has qualified to represent his section in this 2020 state meet at Nassau County Aquatic Center
